“What is man that You are mindful of him, Or the son of man that You take care of him? You have made him a little lower than the angels; You have crowned him with glory and honor, and set him over the works of your hands. You have put all things in subjection under his feet.” Hebrews 2:6-8

♥ **Testimony: looking to God instead of people/ walking in the world.**

A life of good circumstances does not mean that God is with us. And likewise, a life of trial and suffering does not mean that God is not with us! If we base our lives on our circumstances, we are no different than people without God. What makes us different is that we have something far greater than our circumstances! We have a relationship with the Living God!

When I began this walk with God back in 1978 one of the first things He revealed to me is the simple truth that most of His teachings come forth in our lives in a very practical manner as we experience His ways, walking and talking with Jesus on a daily basis. I had been a believer in the saving grace of Jesus for 17 years previous before walking in the world’s way for 8 years. I had no concept of Lordship. I knew Him as my Savior and never doubted my salvation experience which had given me a simple **experimental** knowledge of the cleansing power of His blood.. It was later that I had the **experiential** knowledge of His love for me. Praise God for His precious Blood of Jesus.

Sadly, it was through many hardships, trials and disobedience that brought me to a place of true submission to His loving kindness that led me to repentance and Lordship in my life. Several times in scripture we are told that He has crowned us with glory and honor, but it is not always an easy thing to grasp and live by. Thus I pray:

♥ ***“Let this mind be in you which was also in Christ Jesus, who, being in the form of God, did not consider it robbery to be equal with God, but made Himself of no reputation, taking the form of a bondservant, and coming in the likeness of men. And being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself and became obedient to the point of death, even the death of the cross. Therefore God also highly exalted Him.” Philippians 2:5-9***

He reminded me that the wrath of man never works the righteousness of God and that many times we hinder His righteousness from coming forth because of our wrath. May God have mercy on us as we continue to learn His ways on a daily basis. I thank the Lord for teaching us true humility.

♥ **What am I learning and how am I walking through this?**

He will use situations and circumstances to reveal places that need adjustment. All you have to do is be willing to yield and to refuse to respond defensively or take correction as rejection and become offended. He is refining us as we grow in His kingdom. You will be glad that you surrendered to this process. Truly! ☺

Be still and do not overreact to discouraging news or things that intrude into your life and threaten your tranquility. Maintain peace in the process of responding to situations that are difficult or challenging. You must keep yourself in spiritual flow, faith and peace. Refuse every temptation to fear. Discouragement will try to kill your anointing and your place of stability in God.

Make room for what is coming. Much of what we may have refused to let go of has actually become an anchor/baggage that holds you back. God calls us to raise our anchors and unfurl our sails so that the wind of the Holy Spirit can move us into the freedom of God’s purposes for us. He is the only anchor we need.

♥ God is revealing the truth of situations and circumstances so that you can deal with issues that continue to keep you from the flow of the Holy Spirit. Be open and receive the wisdom that He is pouring forth into your life. There

are changes to be made if you are to prosper in this new season. If you try to protect your sin or pain or keep it covered, it will only cause harm.

♥ **God's grace is not an excuse to sin. But rather a reason to love and serve Him more fully.**

♥ **Holiness Is Not an Option:** Just as He who called you is holy, so be holy in all you do; it is written: "**Be holy, because I am holy.**" *Peter 1:15-16*

Nothing but the blood of the Lamb of God can cleanse you from sin—past, present, and future!

The reality of the culture of our citizenship as sons and daughters of the Most High God, Ambassadors representing His rule in the earth calls for an attitude of no compromise.

When you do not examine your own practices, even those of us who call ourselves preaching the Kingdom, you may not be as discerning of the depths of paganism that has tried to grip the Church.

The enemy tries to set up roadblocks to hinder your progression and may cause you to feel ignored and overlooked or forgotten about. This might seem like a test of your patience, but it is a direct attack from the enemy to seduce you into negative emotional responses. Your awareness of this condition will make all the difference.

Be honest and open with yourself and with God. Transparency is the order of the day. If sharing, other than with God the Father directly, may it be with trusted mature people.

Ephesians 4:30-32: And do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, by whom you were sealed for the day of redemption. Let all bitterness, wrath, anger, clamor, and evil speaking be put away from you, with all malice. And be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, just as God in Christ forgave you.

- ♥ Beloved, come into the secret place of the Spirit, and make your requests known to the Lord. It is easy to just say prayers without engaging your faith and will, but He is calling you to pray in Spirit and in Truth where your prayers create reality. Come and commune with Him from the depth of your soul, not religiously but genuinely with a heart of faith and surrendered will. Then, watch and see the manifestation outwardly of your inner desires, you will be forever changed.

Have you ever felt like giving up? God's Word says "**and having done all, to stand. STAND therefore, having your loins girt about with truth**" *Ephesians 6:13-14*

When we have reached breaking point, remember that HE is our strength in times of need! The TRUTH is that YOU will stand all the fiery darts of the enemy! Rise up, strengthen your spirit with the truth of God's Word. HE will surely cause you to stand when all around you is sinking sand..... PUT ON THE WHOLE ARMOUR OF GOD and see the power of His Word come to pass in your life! His anchor holds.

- **Prayer: Father, we repent of any jealousy, pride, elitism and selfish ambitions. Forgive us Lord. I pray we yield to your Word and the Holy Spirit: For the word of God is living and powerful, and sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing even to the division of soul and spirit, and of joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart. (Hebrews 4:12)**

Stay truly humble and thankful for the transformation of God. Stay in communion with Christ – Stay in the secret place with God and allow your insights to help you grow.. Love God and love others as you witness the miracles of God transform you from glory-to-glory.

Examine yourselves often, and study the way you treat others. Stay in love and watch God bring even more revelation to your life!

We are all growing and being transformed from glory-to-glory (2 Cor. 3:18) - so may we grow in brotherly/sisterly love.

- ♥ **Isaiah 26:20** Come, my people, enter your chambers, and shut your doors behind you; hide yourself, as it were, for a little moment, until the indignation is past.

All you have to do is to establish your position again. Pray for direction and guidance, and He will answer. There is no way to happiness but through Jesus....HE is the Way ~

Your PURPOSE in life is to get to your Destiny or Vision, but many times a believer's Purpose is purely survival and their faith and focus remains locked into their present needs. *Knowledge of Purpose sustains us and Passion propels us to our Destiny.*

Use His Glory empowered Word building His Kingdom. Acts 2

We must seek first, foremost and only His Kingdom and His righteousness. For over 16 years now, on the first page of my website for Breath Of Life Ministries included in the Logo is the Scripture;

"Thy Kingdom come, Thy will be done in earth, as it is in Heaven" (Luke 11:2, Matthew 6:10)

- **John 14:13** "And whatever you ask in My name, that I will do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son." Esther was granted what she asked for by her husband the King. (Xerxes –Hebrew).

The Father will delight to give you the teaching of the Holy Spirit. If but your ear be open, and your thoughts brought into subjection, and your heart prepared in silence to wait upon God, and to hear what He speaks, He will reveal to you His secrets. With the whisper of His love, teachings will come to you which you had never heard before because of the rush and noise of your own thoughts and efforts. You shall learn how your great work is to listen, and hear, and believe what He promises; to watch and wait and see what He does; and then, in Faith, and worship, and obedience, to yield yourself to His working who works in you mightily.

God makes promises because He wants to keep them. It is the Father's good pleasure to give us the Kingdom.

- ♥ **Are you ever tempted to think that the vision/mission of God's Word to you is impossible? In the natural, it is maybe! If we could do 'it' in our own strength, we wouldn't need HIM!**

Self sufficient or Christ sufficient?

- Stepping out in ministry full time
- Writing my book

Whether it be in our personal life or the corporate church, placing our all--on purpose--in God's Hands and simply doing the right thing at the right time, makes the difference. Such trust and obedient action fans the flame of hope in our hearts, puts fire in our bones, and provides traction toward manifest victory. It makes us over comers. It reminds us that WE CAN DO our small part in GOD's BIG PLAN. The world CAN be a better place--one life at a time, one woman at a time. YOUR LIFE can be better. And you can make a difference for someone else!

What is the key? Prayer and Worship:

You personally:

How is God calling You?

What are your dreams and visions?

What is your passion?

How do you desire to use your gifts and talents?

-Did you know – your gifts make room for you?

-Did you know – God makes a way where there is no other way?

-Did you know that God opens a door no man can shut and closes doors no man can open?

These are all HIS words. Therefore it is true.

♥ **THERE IS HOPE -- GOD'S WAY!**

God's way is not dependant on natural, human resources. Those resources fluctuate. They are unreliable. BUT GOD's Provision never fails. And you can count on Him all the time. It is best to trust and rest in Him.

Gideon learned this lesson. When we examine his life and leadership style in this timid individual, God revealed His "ways and means" to bring hope and deliverance to His people. That victory did not come through vast, overwhelming human or natural resources. It came, instead, through one who would lead God's way and who a few people of quality who remained committed to God's purpose. It came through the leadership of one who, on the one hand, realized his own inadequacy, impotency, and inability, but who, on the other hand, believed that He could trust God, and so, chose to do God's will God's way. Esther is another example.

We don't have to be afraid of the unknown. It is only unknown to us. God is well aware of where you are and of every step He is asking you to take to share the Light of Jesus.

- ♥ **The sheep that are My own hear and are listening to My voice, and I know them and they follow Me,
And I give them eternal life, and they shall never lose it or perish through out the ages --- to all eternity they shall never by any means be destroyed. And no one is able to snatch them out of My hand
My father, Who has given them to Me, is greater and mightier than all else; and no one is able to snatch them out of the Father's hand.
I and the Father are One. John 10: 27-30**

As in John 17:

To truly know the Bridegroom Jesus, we need to know the love of the Father. Jesus only did what the Father was doing.

Is God ruler of heaven and earth? Is He almighty? Is He omnipotent? Does He sit King of the flood? The answer to all these questions, of course, is yes., God wants us to have another revelation of Him: He is saying; **"I have chosen who I want to be to you, how I want you to see Me. I want you to know Me as your loving heavenly Father."**

We choose to accept and know that our hearts are an open Gate to Heaven (**swing wide ye heavenly gates, lift up ye heads Oh ye Gates so the King of Glory can come in**) – where God infuses us with His presence and revelation – flowing to us and through us in naturally, supernatural natural ways. We can position our hearts to dwell in His unfailing precious love and remain there abiding in HIM and HE in us – no matter what happens in life for us. I encourage you to read **Psalms 91**.

Grace of His Presence:

Your Father who made the heavens, who established the earth, does what He says He will do! From the realm of revelation of the grace of Abba Father in your life will also be the revealing of the "deep things of God,". The deep things that He chooses to give to you will open the eyes of your heart to see His vastness, and your children and their children will know how big He really is. And you will rejoice. And they will rejoice in all that He does and will do.

Deuteronomy 29:27

Seated with Him:

Jesus Himself called on God as, "Abba Father," as He faced the Cross. He said, **"Abba, Father, all things are possible for You" (Mark 14:36)**. Whatever cross or burden you are bearing, calling out to Abba Father is calling out

for the impossible to become possible. You have access to a Father who knows the beginning from the end and the end from the beginning, so the trust factor is limitless. You can trust Him without end. He will never fail you.

But as it is written: **"Eye has not seen, nor ear heard, nor have entered into the heart of man the things which God has prepared for those who love Him. But God has revealed them to us through His Spirit. For the Spirit searches all things, yes, the deep things of God" (1 Corinthians 2:9-10).**

When your flesh is silent, the Holy Spirit expands the inner man not through head knowledge but through the revelatory realm of revelation of illumination in the inner man to yet deeper depth of His greatness. That you, being so rooted in Him as Father God, are set in for your coming moment, for your coming day in Christ for your destiny, which is His will for your life. Nothing is impossible for Him. This deeper revelation establishes us into a faith that brings forth works that really believe nothing is impossible for Him. Jesus said, **"...nevertheless, not what I will, but what You will" (Mark 14:36). What He wills is the Father heart of God.**

Are you willing to say, "Father, I believe You... I believe You?" when He says that it is possible to believe for a city in a day? For the funds that you need today? For the healing that you need today? For your family to be saved?

He confirms our inheritance. Mountains move at His presence. Sinai itself was moved at the presence of God!

- ♥ Everything—every treasure, the riches, the gifts, every increase is to bring attention to His precious presence. It will become a day of, "Behold now the Lord your God." They will see the gifts, see the treasures as you point and say, "Ah, Lord God! **Behold, You have made the heavens and the earth by Your great power and outstretched arm. There is nothing too hard for You" (Jeremiah 32:17).**

Crowned with the priestly blessing, as the royal priesthood, we are first ministers unto God. We are a chosen generation, a holy nation, His own special people, **"that you may proclaim the praises of Him who called you out of darkness into His marvelous light" (1 Peter 2:9).**

We must come out of the old mind-set and into the mind of Christ where the blazing glory of His glorious presence literally rests upon us and the place as we minister first unto God, and then receive His strategies to touch and impact.

We come into that place of impact as His ministers saying, "Oh Father, Your Word says..." That is the apostolic commissioning. Restoration is here, victory is here. God calls upon the faithful priests to join Him, to go forth to prepare the way.

With His grace comes incredible breakthrough, an empowerment by the Holy Spirit to explode into who you are in the Lord! Shake off the dust, silence the flesh and the Lord will arise from His holy habitation, stirring you to arise with Him, for incredible, unbelievable breakthrough in every area. We are more than conquerors.

Revelation of the living, powerful, true, Word of the Lord in you and His vastness of light will pierce, penetrate and dispel all darkness. He will accomplish His whole work in you. Receiving the Lord's grace is an act of a victorious conqueror.

♥ **Abba Father has created you to live and move and have your being in HIM and maturity brings unity in the Body of Christ.**

His love matures and establishes you so that you are victoriously triumphant with Him as a royal priest, sons/daughters of God, the Body of Christ, the Bride of Christ proclaiming His presence to a world of lost people that desperately need Him.

We are being equipped and adorned and conformed into His image to advance the King in His Kingdom; God's Kingdom!

- Similar was Esther that had favor even in the Harem as she prepared to be with the King, and then even advanced to be the queen. She was humble and submitted to what was being asked of her. Deep within knowing who she was and that she had a purpose.....a destiny.

In our being **separated/set apart** unto the Lord will we discover *hope and opportunity and destiny. (Hosea 2:14).*

Our divine purpose of our lives must be union with Christ (Ephesians 5:14-18).

Abandoned yourself in passionate love for Christ our Lord, and King and walk in the power of His resurrection. We cannot have true Kingdom power until we fully embrace the King.

We have ears to hear what the Lord is saying, eyes to see what He is doing. It is time to humble ourselves and cleave to the Spirit of God and obey. We must repent and turn from our selfish ambitions, die to ourselves, pick up our cross and follow the Lamb of God wherever He goes.

Remember what the Lord said to Joshua: **"You have never been where you are now going" (Joshua 3:4).** As Joshua was warned/told to be prepared in his day, a day like no other, we, too, are being prepared for the glorious move of the Spirit of God.

May we all covenant with the Father as Jesus did;

"Not my will but Thine be done." (Luke 22:42)
